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MESSAGE OF VICE CHANCELLOR DSU PROF. DR. MUHAMMAD AFZAL

Dear DSU Community

I got good tidings on the earlier issue of DSU e-Newsletter from the DSU and outside communities for being so informative and illuminating with regard to our endeavors for improving quality of service, academic excellence, collaborative pursuits and entrepreneurship. Year 2023 was overall a good year for DSU. During the year we continued our efforts to make DSU a sustainable institution by launching new programs as per market appetite. We are now in the process of translating our long term vision into first ever DSU's strategic plan for the next 15 years. A number of new initiatives for development have been taken. Recently we have introduced Artificial Intelligence in response to market demand. Suffa Soft and Centre for CAD have been established. Developing Soft skills for students and pedagogical innovations remains our priority. Besides, we are working with Software houses like: Systems Limited, 10Pearls, Folio3, Vectracom, Jaffer Business Services and Hazza Limited. We have given boost to academia-industrial linkages and signed a number of fresh MOUs with international and national setups and arranged follow up training programs under the collaborative arrangements. Co-curricular activities have been strengthened and we have tried to glorify campus life for students' engagement. Life at the campus is now getting more exuberant and more appealing. For the first time DSU's ranking has been arranged by THE Time Higher Education Impact Ranking as well as EduRank - World Universities Ranking.

For the year 2024 we have the plans to introduce more programs looking at the market requirement. There will be continued focus on Academic Excellence, improved Alumni Services, Entrepreneurship & Innovation, Global Connection, Startup Ecosystem, Community Impact, Vibrant Campus Life, Expanding Horizons and Pedagogical Innovations. Concerted efforts will be made to improve DSU's Ranking. As per approved plan for DCK, work on Academic Block (18-storey) and Hostel (15-storey) will be expedited. These developments will add to internationalization of the university which will help in its global ranking of the university. DCK has to be made a fully residential campus. This will enable recruitment of international faculty, attract international students and have adequate residential facilities for them. Number of Research Publications will be increased. Accreditation of programs and new initiatives for development will remain under constant focus like always. We are also planning to hold a Convocation early next year.

I thank the readership for their continued patronage and support. Let us strive together for better tomorrow and make DSU as a University of Choice.

Navigating Career Success: Workshop on Strategic Placement and Internship Management






ORIENTATION WEEK


